Refrigerator Exchange Program 2014

- 234 Low- & Moderate-Income Households
- Exchange: 2001 models and older were carefully recycled and replaced with Energy Star models at no cost to homeowners
- Estimated Savings: \$82 -\$170/year per household

Power Saver Retrofits – 2014; Repeat in 2015?

Power Saver Retrofits

- 86 Moderate/Low Income Households
- Home Performance with Energy Star Audit
- Up to \$8,000 in Energy Efficiency Retrofits
- More than \$63,000 in savings per year;
 ~\$750/yr/household





Neighborhood Green/My Brookies Actions



Install a rain barrel or cistern



Redirect your rooftop runoff with a downspout disconnect to a splash block



Have a stormwater audit or landscape plan competed that includes landscape practices to filter stormwater



Follow an urban nutrient management plan completed by a contractor

Replace 30 square feet or more of turf grass or other surface with conservation landscaping using native plants
